# THIS YEAR AT VINE (from Director, Liz Linnitt)

What a busy year it has been. This has been our 16<sup>th</sup> year as a charity and we continue to offer one to one face to face professional counselling to people in the community who need support with issues such as anxiety, depression, stress, loneliness, bereavement, abuse, trauma, family issues. Like so many charities, Vine has had its challenges this year, with increasing demand for our services in a cost of living crisis. However, we end the year humbled by the support we have received, the community spirit we have experienced and a renewed commitment to provide our services for many years to come.

The charity currently supports around 60 adult clients each week, many from local villages e.g, Congresbury, Wrington, Langford, Churchill, Flax Bourton, Yatton, Winscombe but also from Clevedon, Weston Super Mare and Bristol. The children and young people service is currently on hold but we hope to resume this service later in 2024 following a consultation and recruitment process.

We receive around 10-15 new enquiries each week and our Operations Director, Tracy, manages the waiting list exceptionally well, keeping it as short as possible. To request an appointment, you can self refer but also enquiries are being received through local GPs and other agencies, as well as via our website, personal recommendations and excellent reputation locally for a top class and professional service, in a climate of acceptance and ethical practice.

We have a 'What is Counselling' sheet which can be found on the website but also sent out to potential clients when they make an enquiry and this is helpful as it explains what counselling actually is to enable them to make an informed decision about whether it is what they are looking for. The GPs also have copies of these to give to patients.
